Leroy Doucet Estate.....Condemnation of property located at 408 Avenue C =

Introduce Ordinance #16-504/Prohibited Deposits on Private or Public Property by Animals = Don stated we are adding some sections under this ordinance. The model was from the Lafayette ordinance and from the City of Mandeville ordinance. Councilman Bonin questioned if this will protect out park also? Don stated yes it will. Councilman Bonin questioned the Chief if it will help the Chief protect out park? Chief Decou stated he didn't receive it yet. Moved by Councilman Bonin and second by Councilman Foco to introduce Ordinance #16-504, an ordinance of the City of Broussard amending the Broussard Code of Ordinances, Chapter Ten (10), animals and to add Article III, prohibited deposits on private or public property by animals, and to thereto, to Chapter 10, Section 10-35 and 10-36 and reserving sections 10-28 through 10-34 and Chapter 10. Comeaux Engineering/Walter Comeaux....Approved change order for Lift Station and Force Main at Sabal Palms II = Walter stated this is the Sabal Palms Lift Station. The lift station is essentially complete. This change order adjusts various items. At the request of the City they wanted a spectra shield. \$10,239.00 for the change order. Moved by Councilman Foco and second by Councilman Higginbotham to approve the change order for the Lift Station and Force Main at Sabal Palms II in the amount \$10,239.00.

PENSCO/AI Reaux.....Highway 182 Overlay = AI stated they are addressing the drainage now. At the end of the week they will move to St. Cecelia to do the patching where there is a road failure. Then after that they will start with the overlay. It should be 2 or 3 days. We are not putting pipe in. The pipe is crushed. It will be addressed when we overlay the road. Mayor Langlinais stated if you swale it; you will be right back to the same situation. AI stated there was a barrier on the road, preventing the water from moving back. That was the change order. Councilman Bourque questioned how long he has? AI stated they have 90 days and they have 46 days into the project. We will stop right at St. Des. Porres.
